




**Mobility package weekly rest**

 (from 20-08-2020) Regular WR shall be taken in suitable gender-friendly accommodation with adequate sleeping and sanitary facilities

 (from 20-08-2020) Drivers are able to return to the employer's operational centre where the driver is normally based and where the driver's weekly rest period begins, in the Member State of the employer's establishment, or to return to the drivers' place of residence

 (from 20-02-2022) Organise its vehicle fleet's activity in such a way as to ensure that vehicles that are at the disposal of the undertaking and are used in international carriage return to one of the operational centres in that Member State at least within eight weeks after leaving it (1071/2009)

**Extra notes:**

Weekly driving time (56 hours) and two weekly driving times (90 hours)

It is important to register the travelling time (when return home driver), in accordance with Article 9, correctly in the tachograph.

A weekly rest period that spans two weeks may be counted in either but not in both. (the number of hours is in the weeks that is counted)

**Example 5** Starting on Monday after a total weekly rest of more than 132 hours (driver and vehicle were both at home). Two consecutive reduced weekly rest periods outside the Member State of the employer's establishment and the country of the drivers' place of residence

A weekly rest period that spans two weeks may be counted in either but not in both. For example the weekly rest in week 2 starts on Sunday week 1 and ends on Monday week 2. The same in week 3, 5 and 6.

Practically it may be best to return home driver and vehicle in week 7. Otherwise at the latest in week 8 return home vehicle.

**Example 6** Three weeks on and one weeks off

Starting on Monday after a total weekly rest of more than 132 hours (42+45+xx+45 driver and vehicle were both at home). Two consecutive reduced weekly rest periods outside the Member State of the employer's establishment and the country of the drivers' place of residence

A weekly rest period that spans two weeks may be counted in either but not in both. For example the weekly rest in week 2 starts on Sunday week 1 and ends on Monday week 2. The same in week 3, 5 and 6.
